

| NEA SMYRNI SUBURB |

Nea Smyrni is a southern suburb of Athens-Greece and it is located between the Historical Centre and the coastal line. It was named after the famous city Smyrna (today's Izmir in Turkey), from where a large number of refugees arrived and settled in the Nea Smyrni area in 1922. It is classified as an above the average living standards suburb.

Distances and Transportation

- ✓ 4 km far from the historical centre of Athens
- ✓ 3 km far from the coastal line
- ✓ 6 tram stations, which are connected with the metro network
- ✓ Extended bus station network
